Opposition to application for extension of time to file petition for writ

of certiorari

Dear Mr. Harris:

Respondents oppose petitioners' application for a 60-day extension of time. Counsel for petitioners recently filed two unsuccessful petitions for certiorari from unpublished Ninth Circuit decisions that addressed the same legal issue. See Penning v. Service Employees International Union, Local 1021, No. 20-15226; Mark Gabriele v. Service Employees International Union, Local 1000, No. 21-1300. Accordingly, petitioners' counsel does not need to conduct extensive research to file a petition for certiorari from the Ninth Circuit's January 26, 2022 unpublished decision here. Moreover, petitioners already extended their deadline for seeking certiorari in this case by filing an unsuccessful petition for rehearing. Respondents do not oppose a 30-day extension of time, which would allow the petition to be considered at the long conference.
