Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned matter was placed on the docket on September 19, 2022. The response of Mountain Valley Pipeline, LLC (“Mountain Valley”) is currently due on October 19, 2022.

Mountain Valley respectfully requests, under Rule 30.4 of the rules of this Court, an extension of time of 30 days—to and including November 18, 2022—within which to file any response. The petition presents questions regarding whether federal district courts may entertain certain claims pertaining to the Natural Gas Act and its eminent domain provisions. Undersigned counsel are working diligently, but respectfully submit that additional time is needed to complete their analysis of the petition.

The Solicitor General has requested, and this Court recently granted, a 30-day extension of time to prepare the government’s response, to and including November 18, 2022. Mountain Valley’s requested extension would align the deadlines for any responses by both Respondents, and facilitate the efficient presentation of issues for this Court’s review.
