

## **APPLICATION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME**

Pursuant to Rule 13.5 of the Rules of this Court, Applicant Trisha Doran hereby requests a 60-day extension of time within which to file a petition for a writ of certiorari up to and including Friday, July 15, 2022.

## **JUDGMENT FOR WHICH REVIEW IS SOUGHT**

The judgment for which review is sought is *Doran v. McDonough*, No. 20-3694 (November 9, 2021) (attached as Exhibit 1). The Sixth Circuit denied Applicant's motion for rehearing on February 15, 2022 (attached as Exhibit 2).

## **JURISDICTION**

This Court will have jurisdiction over any timely filed petition for certiorari in this case pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1254(1). Under Rules 13.1, 13.3, and 30.1 of the Rules of this Court, a petition for a writ of certiorari was due to be filed on or before May 16, 2022. In accordance with Rule 13.5, this application is being filed more than 10 days in advance of the filing date for the petition for a writ of certiorari.

## REASONS JUSTIFYING AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Applicant respectfully requests a 60-day extension of time within which to file a petition for a writ of certiorari seeking review of the decision of the Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals in this case, up to and including July 15, 2022.

1. Applicant apologizes for delay due to unexpected death in family.
2. Pro se Applicant has requested Mr. Richard Renner to assist in the preparation of the petition that addresses important civil rights and constitutional statutes of national importance. Counsel will make an appearance if extension to file is granted.
3. An extension of time will permit new counsel adequate time to thoroughly research and complete a cogent and well-researched petition for this Court.

## CONCLUSION

For the foregoing reasons, Applicant respectfully requests that this Court grant an extension of 60 days, up to and including July 15, 2022, within which to file a petition for a writ of certiorari in this case.
