Dear Mr. Harris:

I write pursuant to this Court's Rule 30.4 to request a 25-day extension of the time to file Plaintiff Voter Respondents' brief in opposition in the above-captioned case, which is currently due on August 10, 2022. I am counsel of record in the case.

In addition to this matter, I am involved in a number of active litigation matters in federal court that require my attention over the next several weeks, including redistricting litigation in Georgia and Mississippi. A 25-day extension will also accommodate longstanding family vacation plans beginning on August 1.

In addition, a 25-day extension of the time to file the brief in opposition will allow Respondents to review any amicus briefs filed in support of the petition prior to the filing of the brief in opposition, and to respond to any points in those briefs, if necessary. Thus far, at least three separate groups have contacted Respondents to seek consent for the filing of such amicus briefs.

I contacted Petitioner Ritter's counsel before filing this letter and he indicated that he consents to the request.
