SUPPLEMENTAL ARGUMENT

The Question Presented by the Petition is "Does the Fourteenth Amendment require meaningful review of restrictions on the right to engage in a common occupation?" Petitioners submit this supplemental brief because a judge of the Fifth Circuit just addressed that question. Golden Glow Tanning Salon, Inc. v. City of Columbus, No. 21-60898 (Nov. 8, 2022) (Ho, J., concurring) (slip op. 11–15). Specifically, Judge Ho surveyed the right's "deep roots in our Nation's history and tradition" before noting the pendency of the Petition before this Court. Like the arguments in the Petition, the history presented by Judge Ho justifies a grant of certiorari.
