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**SUGGESTIONS OF DEATH AND MOOTNESS**

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Counsel for petitioner hereby gives notice of the December 30, 2022 death of the petitioner in this case, Gigi Jordan. The case is accordingly now moot. See, e.g., *Bruno v. Secretary, Florida Department of Corrections*, 700 F.3d 445, 445 (11th Cir. 2012) (“The death of the habeas petitioner renders a habeas action moot.”); *Keitel v. Mazurkiewicz*, 729 F.3d 278, 280 (3d Cir. 2013) (a habeas petitioner’s death means that she “is no longer ‘in custody’” and her “habeas petition has been rendered moot”).

Counsel for respondent agrees with the suggestions of death and mootness.
