Dear Mr. Harris:

I am writing on behalf of the Petitioners to respond to Respondent's request for a 50-day extension of time to respond to the Petition for Writ of Certiorari in this case. Petitioners' considered position follows.

The Petition was filed on November 16, 2022, after which Respondents had the ability to respond by December 16, 2022 under Rule 15(3). Instead of doing so, a notice of appearance was filed by counsel along with a waiver of a response on December 15, 2022. The Petition was distributed the next day for a conference on January 6, 2023. The day following, December 22, 2022, the Court requested a response to be filed 32 days hence, by January 23, 2022.

On December 28, 2022, Respondent asked for an additional 50-days for a combined 82-day extension through March 14, 2023, with the explanation that counsel had been recently retained and needed time to review the record, study the case law, and prepare the brief. Respondent also noted that counsel has "several other briefs" with approaching deadlines.

The Memorandum Concerning The Deadlines For Cert Stage Pleadings that is posted on the Court's website indicates that a request for extension of more than 30 days should include a statement as to Petitioner's position on the extension and that "[e]xtensions beyond 30 days are possible but depend on the circumstances and the views of the other parties to the case." Here, Respondent did not contact Petitioners before asking for the 50-day extension let alone indicate Petitioners' position in their request. Moreover, under the circumstances, such a lengthy extension may not be reasonable as it would result in a four-month extension of time from when the Petition was filed on November 16, 2022. In addition, trial of the case has been set by the district court for March 6, 2023, which pre-dates the requested extension date of March 14 for Respondents to oppose the Petition. (Exhibit.)

Petitioners hesitate to oppose any reasonable request for an extension of time particularly in this Court and given the gravity of the issues presented in this case. Under the circumstances, however, Petitioners respectfully suggest that an extension of no more than 30 days, through February 22, 2022, would be reasonable for Respondent to respond to the Petition. This position is stated with the utmost respect for the ability of Respondent's capable counsel to adequately address the issues with the assistance of the trial attorneys who have been involved in the action since its commencement.
