**PETITIONER, RICHARD WINN'S MOTION FOR
LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS**


The Petitioner, RICHARD WINN, by his court-appointed counsel, CHRISTOPHER G. FURLONG, Esquire, asks leave to file the accompanying Petition for Writ Certiorari without prepayment of costs and to proceed in forma pauperis. Petitioner has previously been granted leave to so proceed in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania (No. 17-651-02) and in the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit (No. 20-1447). Petitioner's counsel was appointed to represent the Petitioner in the District Court for replacement of Petitioner's previously appointed counsel who represented the Petitioner up to and including trial. Petitioner's present counsel was appointed subsequent to trial and has represented the Petitioner from that point forward including sentencing and in his appeal before the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit. The Petitioner's counsel has continued with that representation pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act, 18 U.S.C. §3006A.

The Petitioner is unable to pay the fees and the costs for this Petition or give security therefore. In addition, there has been no substantial favorable change in Petitioner's financial condition since his initial incarceration from September 15, 2017, finding of guilt upon conclusion of a trial, sentencing and appeal to the United States Court of Appeals for the Third Circuit. The Petitioner has been continuously afforded court-appointed counsel since his incarceration and an Indictment in the Eastern District of Pennsylvania and has been continuously incarcerated as previously stated. In accordance with Rule 39.1 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, no Affidavit of Petitioner is attached to the instant Motion.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner prays that this Court grant leave to proceed in this action before this Court in forma pauperis.
