**ORDER MODIFYING CONDITIONAL RELEASE**

This matter having come before the Court on a motion for Unconditional Release or to Modify Conditions of Release of defendant, Davis Lamar Brooks.

The Court after hearing from all parties, the Court rules that the defendant will remain on Conditional Release with the following modifications to the current Conditional Release Order:

- 1) The defendant shall remain under the care of Region 8 Mental Health Services in Rankin County, MS. The defendant shall receive monthly injections of Haloperidol (brand name: Haldol) at 100 mg per dosage unit/injection. The attending physician, at Region 8 Mental Health Services, may adjust the dosage unit only for medical reasons and not at the request of the defendant. If the dosage unit is altered the attending physician must submit, in writing to U.S. Probation Service, the basis for the dosage unit adjustment.
- 2) The attending Physician, at Region 8 Mental Health Services, must submit a written examination and prognoses of the defendant, every six (6) months to the U.S Probation Serve. The reports will then be forwarded to the Court, Federal Public Defender's Office and the U.S. Attorney's Office.

- 3) The defendant shall submit his current address and notify the United States Probation Service of any change of address.
- 4) All prior conditions are hereby removed.

The Court further orders the U.S. Probation Service to conduct the following:

- 1) The U.S. Probation Service shall provide, to the defendant's attending physician, a copy of defendant's criminal history.
- 2) The U.S. Probation Service shall interview the defendant's sister, Thelma Taylor, to determine if she has any criminal history.
