Dear Mr. Harris:

I serve as counsel of record for Respondent the State of Mississippi in the above-captioned case. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari was docketed on June 2, 2022. Though Mississippi waived the right to file a response to the petition, the Supreme Court requested that a response be filed on or before October 13, 2022. Under Supreme Court Rule 30.4, I respectfully request an extension of thirty-two (32) days, to and including Monday, November 14, 2022, within which to file Mississippi's Response in Opposition.

An extension of time is necessary because I have many competing obligations in the coming weeks, including the filing of multiple briefs and responses in the Mississippi Supreme Court, preparation for oral arguments, and administrative duties as Director of the Criminal Appeals Division.
