Upon a review of the record, the response to the court's November 4, 2021 order, and the opening brief filed on November 4, 2021, we conclude this appeal is frivolous. We therefore deny appellant's motion to proceed in forma pauperis (Docket Entry No. 3) and dismiss this appeal as frivolous, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2).
