**PETITIONER'S MOTION AND AFFIRMATION  
FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS***

1. This case is before the Court on a petition for writ of certiorari.
2. Petitioner is a serving a sentence of life without parole in the above-captioned matter and is sentenced to death on a separate matter.
