
Dear Mr. Harris:

I am counsel for the respondent in this case. Petitioner filed his petition for a writ of certiorari on June 16, 2022, which was docketed on August 23, 2022. According to the online docket and pursuant to Rule 15.3 of the Rules of the Supreme Court of the United States, a response is currently due on September 22, 2022. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, respondent respectfully requests that the time for filing a response be extended by 29 days, to and including October 21, 2022.

This is respondents' first request for an extension of time to file a response. Good cause exists for the requested extension. I am not currently admitted to the U.S. Supreme Court but am submitting my application for admission next week. 
Accordingly, respondent respectfully requests that the time for filing a response to the petition for writ of certiorari be extended by 29 days, to and including October 21, 2022.
