Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on September 7, 2022. Although the government waived its right to file a response, the Court has requested that a response be filed. The government's response is now due, after one extension, on December 2, 2022. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including December 8, 2022, within which to file a response.
