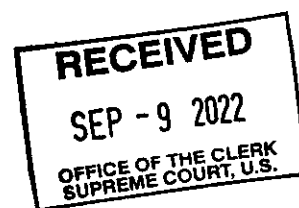

STATEMENT OF THE CASE
