# STATEMENT OF THE CASE

I John Doe have epilepsy.

Feb, 14 2016, I had an epileptic seizure while driving. I crashed three vehicles, I was charged with failure to render aid. I was taken to jail even though I was involved in three crashes and still having seizures. I was put into maximum security, with no medical treatment. I had not recovered from the seizures or the crashes. I was then beaten by twelve inmates and sexually assaulted. I was woke up off the floor with my pants to my ankles and blood and feces on my legs. While being moved from maximum security to a elevator, I was having another seizure so I leaned towards the deputy. But instead of helping me he grabbed me around the neck and choked me against the wall of the elevator and told me not to touch him again and said "I got you". I was taken to a shower to wash off the blood and feces. I was then placed in the hole for assaulting an officer. I still never received medical treatment. As a result I had eight more seizures in the hole. I received a pill when I was being released. I went to the hospital and doctor said I would have died if I stayed a little longer. I suffered brain injury, back injury, damaged nerves in hand and lost five teeth had to have...

### REASONS FOR GRANTING THE PETITION

The first attorney I hired, sabotaged my case for the defendants by missing deadlines, not adding important information into my case by deadlines, and removing himself from my legal representation without informing me. The case was dismissed, I had to hire another attorney to file an appeal. But that went nowhere because she's not allowed to input information that was not filed by the first attorney. So the appeal was affirmed. Now I am dealing with the highest court in the land, to hear my pain and suffering. Amen
