Dear Mr. Harris,

We represent Respondent, Nippon Yusen Kabushiki Kaisha (hereinafter, "Respondent") in the above-referenced matter. We write to request a 30-day extension of time, up to and including February 13, 2023, within which to file its opposition to the petition for a writ of certiorari to review the judgment of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fifth Circuit in this matter.

On November 3, 2022, Justice Alito extended the time to file the petition to December 14, 2022. Accordingly, petitioner submitted its petition for writ of certiorari on December 14, 2022. Thus, the present deadline for the brief in opposition is January 13, 2023.

The reason for this request is to allow Respondent time to address the issues raised in the petition, particularly considering that the winter holidays limit Respondent's time to less than it would have had if the petition was filed by the

initial November 14, 2022 deadline. Additionally, Respondent has conferred with Petitioner as to the requested extension and Petitioner has agreed to same.

Accordingly, Respondent respectfully requests that it be granted a 30-day extension, up to and including February 13, 2023, within which to file an opposition to the Petition for a writ of certiorari.
