Dear Mr. Scott,

Petitioners write to alert the Court to two additional Petitions for a Writ of Certiorari to be filed by codefendants involving the same issue raised by Petitioners. Petitioners' case has been distributed for conference on November 18, 2022.

On October 11, 2022, Mr. Perry and Mr. Evans filed a joint Petition for a Writ of Certiorari which bears the above case number. As noted in the petition, a writ is sought from the decision of the Fifth Circuit Court of Appeals involving 10 codefendants: *United States v. Jasmine Perry* consolidated with *United States v. Leroy Price, Alonzo Peters, Curtis Neville, Solomon Doyle, Damian Barnes, Ashton Price, McCoy Walker, Terrioues Owney, Evans Lewis*, No. 1730610 c/w 17-30611 (5th Cir. May 12, 2022).

It has come to Petitioners' attention that two codefendants are filing Petitions for a Writ of Certiorari involving the same issue raised by Petitioners. It is our understanding that Terrioues Owney e-filed and posted his petition yesterday. Another, Curtis Neville, will e-file and post his petition today. Both sought and received extensions for the filing of their petitions.

Petitioners respectfully suggest that judicial economy would be better served by consolidating all the petitions for consideration at a later date.
