Dear Mr. Harris:

The petition for a writ of certiorari in the above-captioned case was filed on October 18, 2022. The government's response is now due, after three extensions, on March 20, 2023. We respectfully request, under Rule 30.4 of the Rules of this Court, a further extension of time to and including March 24, 2023, within which to file a response.

The reason for this short extension is that the government seeks to file its briefs in response to several petitions for writs of certiorari presenting similar questions on the same day, so that the Court may more easily consider the petitions in relation to one another.

Counsel for petitioners does not oppose this further extension.
