MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Petitioner, Glenn Randall Ferguson, an indigent party in this case, moves for leave to proceed in forma pauperis for the purpose of filing a Petition for Writ of Certiorari.

Petitioner's financial indigency was recognized by the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Oklahoma, which on March 30, 2017 appointed the Office of Federal Public Defender identified below to represent Petitioner pursuant to the Criminal Justice Act (18 U.S.C. §3006A). A copy of the appointment order is attached to this Motion. On August 18, 2020, United States Court of Appeals for the Tenth Circuit granted the motion of the Office of Federal Public Defender to continue its appointment to represent Petitioner in that court. Since the original appointment on March 30, 2017, the Petitioner has since been continuously represented by his appointed counsel.

Petitioner requests that this Court grant leave to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39.1, and permit Petitioner to submit his Petition for Writ of Certiorari without prepayment of filing fees and costs.
