MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED *IN FORMA PAUPERIS*

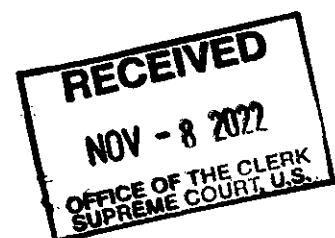
The Petitioner asks leave to file the attached petition for a Writ of habeas Corpus without prepayment of costs and to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
