Dear Mr. Harris:

I serve as counsel of record for Respondent in the above-captioned case. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari was docketed on November 15, 2022. Pursuant to Rule 15.3 of the Rules of this Court, a response is due on December 15, 2022. Pursuant to Rule 30.4, I respectfully request an extension of 32 days, up to and until Monday, January 16, 2023, within which to file the Brief in Opposition.

An extension of time is necessary because I have a number of competing obligations within the coming weeks.
