O R D E R

Jose Luis Ramirez, Jr., seeks to appeal his sentence imposed following his guilty plea to possession with intent to distribute methamphetamine, in violation of 21 U.S.C. § 841(a). The Government has moved to dismiss the appeal as barred by Ramirez's waiver of the right to appeal included in the plea agreement. Upon review of the record, we conclude that Ramirez knowingly and voluntarily waived his right to appeal and that the issues Ramirez seeks to raise on appeal fall squarely within the scope of his waiver of appellate rights. Accordingly, we grant the Government's motion to dismiss.
