Request for Extension of Time/Capital Case

Dear Sir:

On October 25, 2022, Petitioner, Albert Holland, filed his petition for writ of certiorari. The Office of the Attorney General was served on December 6, 2022. The undersigned counsel has had an oral argument scheduled before the Florida Supreme Court, two separate responses to post-conviction motions for relief, a response to an All Writs petition before the Florida Supreme Court and an answer brief for the Eleventh Circuit all scheduled for December through the first week of January 2023, all on capital cases, in addition to several court appearances during this time. Consequently, the State is requesting an extension of time to file its brief in opposition pursuant to Supreme Court Rules 15 and 30, a forty-five (45) day extension, up to and including February 17, 2023.

No previous extensions have been requested. Counsel anticipates that the additional forty-five (45) days will be sufficient time to prepare and to file the State's Brief in Opposition in this case.
