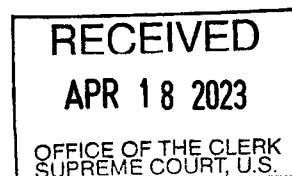

Comes now Albert Holland, Jr. ("Holland")
pro se and moves this Honorable Court
to Rehear and Reconsider this Court's
denial of Holland's Petition For A writ
of Certiorari.

As grounds, Holland says:

1. Pursuant to Supreme Court rule 44
paragraph #2 the Scotus has abused its
discretion by failing to exercise sound,
reasonable, and legal decision-making
in the denial of Holland's Petition For A
writ of Certiorari.
2. The Court's abuse of discretion error
is evident from the record, as Holland
has demonstrated that the lower courts
want of jurisdiction affirmatively appears
in the pleadings and elsewhere in the record.
3. The State of Florida's Brief in opposition
did not refute the lower court's want of
jurisdiction.
4. For over one-hundred years the First
duty of this Scotus where no motion is
made by either party, or on its own motion,
reversed a lower court's want of jurisdiction,
not only in cases where it is shown negatively

that jurisdiction does not exist, but even when it does not appear affirmatively that it does exist.

5. "Neither the lower courts nor the
scotus shall use the judicial power of
the united states in a case which the
constitution and laws of the united
states have not extended that power."

See MANSFIELD, supra.

6. Pursuant to Supreme Court rule
44 paragraph #2 this is a substantial
ground not previously presented.
