Request for extension of time

Dear Mr. Harris:

I write on behalf of respondents to request an extension of time to oppose the petition for a writ of certiorari before judgment in this matter. The current deadline, after one extension, is March 10, 2023. Respondents respectfully seek an additional extension of thirty-one days, until Monday, April 10, 2023, to file an opposition.

This extension is necessary because of the press of work in previously assigned matters requiring the attention of the attorneys most knowledgeable about this case. An extension is appropriate for the additional reason that the appeal in this case will be argued in the Court of Appeals on March 20, 2023, and that argument may be relevant to the petition for a writ of certiorari before judgment. Petitioners' counsel has informed me that petitioners do not consent to this further extension.
