Respondent, the State of Florida, requests a thirty-day extension of time to file its Brief in Opposition to the petition. Sup. Ct. R. 30.4. Counsel handling this case, Senior Assistant Attorney General Charmaine Millsaps is lead counsel in an active warrant capital case, which is currently pending in the Florida Supreme Court. *Dillbeck v. State*, SC23-190. The warrant was signed on January 23, 2023, and she has been handling the warrant litigation in the state trial court since that date and therefore, could not complete the brief in opposition in this case. Due to the unexpected exigency of the warrant litigation, the Secretary requests a 30 day extension of time until March 10, 2023, to complete the brief in opposition.
