*IN FORMA PAUPERIS***


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Petitioner respectfully requests leave to file the accompanying Petition for Writ of Certiorari without prepayment of costs and instead to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

The need for this Motion for Leave stems from the same decision by Respondent State Bar of California from which Petitioner seeks relief. Specifically, in December 2018, the State Bar commenced a disciplinary proceeding against Petitioner that was both unlawful (as more fully set forth in his Petition) and widely publicized, resulting in significant diminution in Petitioner's income-earning capacity.
