MOTION TO PROCEED IN FORMA PAUPERIS

Petitioner, Jeffrey Johnson, by and through his attorney, Jeffrey J. Levine, moves, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, for an order granting him leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* in connection with his Petition for Writ of Certiorari, filed herewith. In support of this Motion, Petitioner states as follows:
