Plaintiff Jose L. Cancel-Cancel, pro se, filed the captioned case seeking, among other things, payment of \$530,000,000; a public apology; sanctions; commemoration and tributes to victims; and effective civilian control of military and security forces (Docket No. 2, pp. 1-2, 9-11). The allegations are similar, albeit not identical, to the ones the court evaluated in the case that plaintiff, pro se, filed at Civil No. 21-1533 (PAD),<sup>1</sup> which the court dismissed. *Id.* at Docket Nos. 32 and 33. This case presents the same problems that led to that dismissal. For that reason, this case is hereby DISMISSED. Judgment shall be entered accordingly.
