Petitioner Richard Galvan Montiel filed a petition for a writ of certiorari in this case on January 11, 2023, and the Court placed it on the docket on January 19, 2023. The California Attorney General's Office represents respondent Kevin Chappell, Warden. Respondent's brief in opposition to the petition is currently due by February 21, 2023.
