





I am being widely blacklisted from employment opportunities and continue to be victimized by wage-theft that dates back to 2012. I had an oral arguments hearing on 5/24/22 in Komatsu v. NTT Data, Inc., No. 101264/2021 (Sup. Ct. NY Cty.) partly about that wage-theft and a violation of a discovery order on 4/12/13 by NTT Data, Inc. that may possibly enable me to be awarded monetary damages, but that case is assigned to New York State Supreme Court Judge Alexander Tisch who previously subjected me to judicial misconduct.
