ORDER

The appellant, Adrian Weatherspoon, proceeding *pro se*, filed in this Court a “Notice of Appeal” indicating his desire to appeal a November 15, 2022 order of dismissal from the Shelby County General Sessions Court, Case No. 2136988. Because a direct appeal from a general sessions court does not lie in this Court, it is ORDERED that the appeal is dismissed.

Mr. Weatherspoon has requested permission to proceed as an indigent person. Upon due consideration, the request is denied as moot. A declaration of indigency does not exempt a litigant from the responsibility to pay any costs that are taxed to him at the conclusion of the appeal. *See Fletcher v. State*, 9 S.W.3d 103, 105 (Tenn. 1999).
