To the extent appellant's September 12, 2022 notice of appeal challenges the district court's post-judgment orders denying appellant's motions to combine closed district court cases, we conclude this appeal is frivolous. We therefore dismiss this appeal as frivolous, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2) (court shall dismiss case at any time, if court determines it is frivolous or malicious).

To the extent appellant's September 12, 2022 notice of appeal challenges the district court's judgment entered in this action on July 24, 2020, the appeal is duplicative of closed appeal No. 20-16723.

Consequently, this appeal is dismissed.

All other pending motions are denied as moot.

No further filings will be entertained in this closed case.
