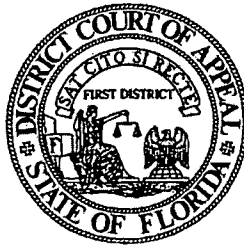

**ORDER DENYING DEFENDANT'S SECOND MOTION FOR REHEARING
WITH
DIRECTIONS TO THE CLERK OF COURT**

THIS CAUSE is before the Court on Defendant's *pro se* second "Motion for Rehearing," provided to prison officials for mailing on October 11, 2022, and filed pursuant to Florida Rule of Criminal Procedure 3.850. Having reviewed the motion, record, and applicable law, the Court finds as follows:

On September 6, 2022, the Court entered an order denying Defendant's successive motion for postconviction relief.

Subsequently, on September 16, 2022, the Court entered an order denying Defendant's second and third amended successive motions for postconviction relief. In that order, the Court found that Defendant's claims are untimely and/or not cognizable in a rule 3.850 motion. The Court further found that the motions constitute an abuse of the legal process.

On September 23, 2022, Defendant provided a Motion for Rehearing to prison officials for mailing.

On September 30, 2022, the Court entered an order denying that motion.

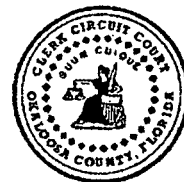
