JURISDICTION CHALLENGE

The North Carolina State Prosecutor has failed or refused to prove jurisdiction over the person on and for the record, being an oath or affirmation signed by, or on behalf of the victim to support probable cause for a warrant to issue. No one has sworn that a crime has been committed and that I, Alphonza Leonard Phillip Thomas-Bey, am the one who committed the crime. Therefore the State Prosecutor has failed to prove that the Court has jurisdiction over the person and has caused the loss of subject-matter jurisdiction rendering all judgments void without an oath or affirmation:

a. The warrant is void. b. The Bill of Indictment is void. c. Any sentence is void. I have been denied due process of law. I have been denied equal protections of the law. I have no way to know the nature and cause of the accusation. I have been denied the right to be confronted with the witness against me. These points a-g are the only cognizable claims I raise.

Where there is no jurisdiction over the subject matter, there is, as well, no discretion to ignore that lack of jurisdiction. [John J. Joyce v. United States of America, 474 F. 2d 215, 219] (c.A.3 (Pa.), 1973)

When it clearly appears that the court lacks jurisdiction, the court has no authority to reach the merits. In such a situation the action should be dismissed for want of jurisdiction. [Melo v. U.S., 505 F. 2d 1026, 1030]

However late this objection has been made in any cause, in an inferior or appellate court of the United States, it must be considered and decided, before any court can move one further step in the cause; as any movement is necessarily the exercise of jurisdiction.

Rhode Island v. Massachusetts, 37 U.S. 657, 718, 9 L. Ed. 1233 (1838)

"Every citizen of this State owes Paramount allegiance to the Constitution and Government of the United States, . . ."] N.C. Const. Sec. 5:
However I am not a U.S. or N.C. corporator or under the Instrumentality rule like, N.C., U.S. Ala. Co. Because of my status and jurisdiction as a MOOFISH American - National Citizen, Natural Person I hereby remove this action to the Federal Court System to: Case No. 1:22-cv-271 via this writ. Even so it is still your duty as a citizen of this State to grant me the following relief:

I have been falsely arrested and wrongfully imprisoned in violation of the protections of the Constitution of the United States. This arrest is unconstitutional and I want to be released from this imprisonment immediately. I move the court to dismiss this case No. 10CR5050755 for lack of subject-matter jurisdiction.

I am NOT BLACK. Here it must be remembered only the "proper status" can be heard in the "proper jurisdiction". Being "Black" is not a district or Superior Court issue and that issue leaves all N.C. and U.S. courts in want of jurisdiction except the U.S. Supreme Court. Ergo only consider issues a-g above, not status, jurisdiction, Federal offense.

Being certified as Black by the U.S. and N.C. must be corrected like my arrest.
ACT IMMEDIATELY TO GRANT THE REQUESTED RELIEF.

In doing so consider issues a-g in this removed action.







Just-in-Time Billionaire

CALENDLY was built out of frustration. Now the scheduling app is worth \$3 billion—and the subject of a heated Twitter spat among Silicon Valley elite.



Just-in-Time Billionaire Cont.

Ukrainian firm Railware. Awotona was in Kyiv eight years ago as protesters battled government forces in the streets. Now, amid the war, Calendly has helped relocate its 10 Ukraine-based contract developers at Railware and has provided financial support to them and their families.

By late 2013, Awotona had a viable product but no cash left. Seed investors, led by Cummings, came to the rescue with a half-million-dollar infusion. Calendly is free for individual users, but typically costs corporations \$25 per user per month. "Employees sing the praises of our product to their higher-ups and it bubbles up," Awotona says. "That's the Trojan horse of how we get into companies."

Enterprise customers can set up customized landing pages, route meetings to specific groups of people and connect their Calendly software to other tools, such as Salesforce, Stripe, Zoom and Hubspot. Large customers, which Calendly defines as those paying more than \$100,000 a year, have grown tenfold over the past 12 months as Calendly has built up its internal sales team. Publicly traded car shopping site CarGurus, for example, has scheduled some 2,000 sales meetings with its dealers through Calendly since signing up last May. That has meant savings of 500 hours of employees' time, says CarGurus senior digital strategist Michael Riley, who led the Calendly rollout.

Last June, US Foods, a large food supplier based outside Chicago, rolled out Calendly to 100 people who work with independent restaurants, mostly mom-and-pop shops. The deal let US Foods set up customized templates for meetings, in both English and Spanish, and incorporate new sales and other outcomes into its strategic planning. "That visibility was a huge selling point for signing an enterprise agreement with Calendly," says David Eschler, vice president of restaurant operations at US Foods. For its corporate customers, Awotona says, the cost of Calendly is more than offset by productivity increases.

The power dynamics of Calendly can be complicated—who invites, who accepts—especially for those professions, like venture capital, in which that kind of thing really matters. Awotona, who says that hasn't been an issue for the typical recruiter or salesperson, watched in amazement as his firm became the object of a Twitter war this winter. Sam Lessin, a VC with Slow Ventures, tweeted about his hatred of Calendly on January 26, calling it "the most raw/naked display of social capital dynamics in business."

"Who hurt you Sam," riposted Dustin Mos-

kovitz, the billionaire Facebook cofounder whose project manager business, Asana, is a Calendly customer. Added VC Marc Andreessen (net worth \$1.7 billion) in a since-deleted tweet: "Notice with immediate effect: Anyone who disregards my Calendly links will be permabanned from raising venture capital in Silicon Valley."

Awotona says the kerfuffle led to tens of thousands of new users signing up. "Our marketing team has spent a lot of time thinking about how to get people talking about Calendly this year. We didn't know the easiest way was to put out some tweets," he says. "We couldn't have planned it better."

Now Awotona, who took the 424-person company fully remote last summer, plans more features to push Calendly further into what needs to happen before meetings (such as having candidates' résumés attached to recruiters' calendar invitations) and after them (such as increased analytics). He's also planning international expansion, believing that the pain of scheduling is felt across all geographies and languages.

"The opportunity to make each meeting efficient and achieve its stated purpose is what we're about," says Awotona, who confesses to spending 25 hours in meetings in an average week. "We see scheduling as an opportunity to set the meeting up for success—how you schedule the meeting, simplified preparation and follow-up. That is our grand vision." ☀

In 2020, before nearly anyone knew what a nonfungible token (NFT) was, OpenSea was a shoestring New York City operation doing \$1 million in transactions per month. Now, the peer-to-peer NFT marketplace is at the center of the latest crypto bubble. Sales of digital real estate (in the metaverse) and pixelated primates topped \$5 billion in January, before falling to \$3.4 billion a month later. Founders Finzer, 31 (right), and Atallah, 30, each own an estimated 18.5% stake in the company, which raised \$300 million in January from private investors who valued the company at \$13.3 billion.

DECACORNS

Worldwide, 30 startups soared past \$10 billion valuations last year—so-called “decacorns,” which are worth 10 times a unicorn—double the number from 2020. Some highlights from these highfliers:

Gary Wang

\$5.9 bil Cryptocurrency exchange U.S.

The 28-year-old is chief technology officer of Bahamas-based FTX, the cryptocurrency exchange he cofounded with Sam Bankman-Fried in 2019. He owns 16% of the company, which garnered a \$32 billion valuation in January, and 18% of its U.S. operations, which are worth \$8 billion.

\$4 bil Software Canada

Max Lytvyn

The Ukraine-born entrepreneurs met while students at International Christian University in Kyiv. They launched the popular grammar checking tool Grammarly more than a decade ago; it was valued at \$13 billion last November. Each has an estimated 35% stake.

Nikil Viswanathan

\$2.4 bil Software U.S.

Joe Lau

\$2.4 bil Software U.S.

The two cofounders each own an estimated 26% of Alchemy, whose software powers thousands of blockchain-based computing firms. In February, Alchemy was valued at \$10.2 billion.

Ion Stoica

\$1.6 bil Software Romania

Matei Zaharia

\$1.6 bil Software Romania

Stoica and Zaharia are two of seven UC Berkeley academics who launched data analyzer Databricks in 2013. Stoica, 57, served as CEO for three years. The company is valued at \$38 billion.

Henrique Dubugras

\$1.5 bil Fintech Brazil

Pedro Franceschi

\$1.5 bil Fintech Brazil

Dubugras, 26, and Franceschi, 25, launched Brex in 2017 and found a niche creating corporate credit cards for well-funded startups. They've signed up tens of thousands of corporate customers and reached a \$12.3 billion valuation in January.

Tang Binsen

\$1.5 bil Beverages China

Tang is CEO of Genki Forest, a Chinese producer of low-calorie drinks that raised \$200 million from Singapore's Temasek Holdings in 2021 at a \$15 billion valuation.

Zach Perret

\$1.5 bil Software U.S.

William Hockey

\$1.4 bil Software U.S.

In 2013, former Bain consultants Perret, 34, and Hockey, 32, launched Plaid to help fintechs connect to consumers' bank accounts. They've ridden the industry's growth to a \$13.4 billion valuation.

Vlad Yatsenko

\$1.1 bil Fintech Ukraine

He cofounded and is chief technology officer of London-based digital banking firm Revolut, which raised money at a \$33 billion valuation last July. He previously built software for UBS, Deutsche Bank and Credit Suisse.

Even as global markets stumbled, the finance-and-investments sector produced more new billionaires (45) than any other this year—including both traditional investors and fintech founders looking to disrupt the status quo. Some of the freshest financial fortunes:

Ramzi Musallam

\$4 bil • Private equity • U.S.

Musallam persuaded outside investors to stick with him and his private equity firm, Veritas Capital, after founder Robert McKeon committed suicide in 2012. Since that time, Veritas has grown from \$2 billion to \$39.5 billion in assets.

Karthik Sarma

\$3.1 bil • Hedge funds • India

Sarma's \$10 billion (assets) SRS Investment Management owns 43% of car rental company Avis, whose shares surged 456% in 2021 on news that it's adding electric vehicles. He founded the firm in 2006 after five years at Tiger Global.

Sergio Fogel

\$1.5 bil • Payments • Uruguay

Andres Bzurovski

\$1.5 bil • Payments • Uruguay

The cofounders of international payments startup DLocal became Uruguay's first billionaires when they took their fintech public in June 2021.

Kristo Käärmann

\$1.4 bil • Money transfer • Estonia

Käärmann, a manager at Deloitte in London, was tired of paying fat fees to send money home to Estonia. So in 2011 he cofounded Wise, which charges about 18% less than industry stalwarts. It went public in London last July.

John Kusuma

\$1.2 bil • Banking • Indonesia

His family owns cigarette maker Nojorono Tobacco International, but his wealth comes from a majority stake in Bank Aladin Syariah, which he acquired over two years starting in 2019.

David Girouard

\$1.2 bil • Lending platform • U.S.

Girouard is cofounder and CEO of San Mateo, California-based Upstart Holdings. His software uses AI to assess borrowers and connect them with banks. It facilitated 1.3 million loans last year.

Harry Klagsbrun

\$1.1 bil • Private equity • Sweden

The seasoned finance exec, who joined private equity firm EQT in 2006, is the Stockholm-listed company's third billionaire. In March EQT said it's buying Baring Private Equity Asia for \$7.5 billion.

Marcelo Kalim


\$1 bil • Digital bank • Brazil

Kalim, a former partner at Brazilian investment bank BTG Pactual, cofounded São Paulo-based digital bank C6 in 2019; JPMorgan bought a 40% stake in it last June for an undisclosed amount.

JOSH KUSHNER

\$2 bil • Venture capital • U.S.

Jared Kushner's younger brother walked away from his family's New York real estate empire to found Thrive Capital in 2010, which made prescient bets on Instagram and Stripe. Goldman Sachs invested in Thrive last May at a \$3.6 billion valuation.

Are You In Denial Of Your Ancestry?

(Excerpt From Documents of American History)

Letter from George Washington to
Muhammed Ibn Abdullah - Sultan of Morocco
City of New York December 1, 1789

Great and Magnanimous Friend,

Since the date of the letter which the late Congress, by their President, addressed to your Imperial Majesty, The United States of America have thought proper to change their government and institute a new one, agreeable to the Constitution, of which I have the honor, herewith, to enclose a copy. The time necessarily employed in the arduous task, and the disarrangements occasioned by so great though peaceable a revolution, will apologize, and account for your Majesty's not having received those regularly advised marks of attention from the United States which the friendship and magnanimity of your conduct toward them afforded reason to expect.

The United States, having unanimously appointed me to supreme executive authority in this Nation. Your Majesty's letter of August 17, 1788, which by reason of the dissolution of the late-government, remained unanswered, has been delivered to me. I have also received the letters which Your Imperial Majesty has been so kind as to write, in favor of the United States, to the Bashaws of Tunis and Tripoli, and I present to you the sincere acknowledgements and thanks of the United States for this important mark of your friendship for them.

We greatly regret the hostile disposition of those regencies toward this nation, who have never injured them, is not to be removed, on terms of our power to comply with. Within our territories there are no mines, either of gold or silver, and this young nation just recovering from the waste and dissolution of a long war, have not, as yet, had time to acquire riches by agriculture and commerce. But our soil is bountiful, and our people industrious, and we have reason to flatter ourselves that we shall gradually become useful to our friends.

The encouragement which Your Majesty has been pleased, generously, to give to our commerce with your dominions, the punctuality with which you have caused the Treaty with us to be observed, and the just and generous measures taken in the case of Captain Proctor, make a deep impression on the United States and confirm their respect for and attachment to Your Imperial Majesty.

It gives me great pleasure to have the opportunity of assuring Your Majesty that, while I remain at the head of this nation, I shall not cease to promote every measure that may conduce to the friendship and harmony which so happily subsist between your Empire and them, and shall esteem myself happy in every occasion of convincing Your Majesty of the high sense (which in common with the whole nation) I entertain the magnanimity, wisdom and benevolence of Your Majesty.

May the Almighty bless Your Imperial Majesty, our Great and Magnanimous friend, with His constant guidance and protection.
