Gage has not previously filed for a leave to proceed in forma pauperis, however there has been a change in circumstance in which it is now needed.

As seen in the accompanied declaration in support of this motion (in compliance with 28 U.S.C. § 1764), Gage does reside in a single income house that predominantly lives paycheck to paycheck. As shown in Gages case, since his disability, a lot of circumstance have changed outside of his control including that of his health which he is currently experiencing issues with. Without arguing issues of the case here, Gage is re-experiencing his frequent debilitating headaches among constants of other issues as well as needing other/more multiple tumor removal surgery's which in the past have required anesthesia-based outpatient operating rooms. Gages and his wife need the money they have in order to pay for the

appointments but also for her to take time off work and care for their 5-year-old, 2-year-old and 7 month old.

WHEREFORE, for the above stated reasons and pursuant to Rule 39 of the Supreme Court Rules, Petitioner requests that he be granted leave to proceed in forma pauperis.


