Syllabus: Depart from the accepted and usual course of judicial proceeding or sanction, such a departure by a lower court as to call for an exercise of this court's supervisory power

Rule 14(a) The questions presented for review

I 1981. Interference with commerce by threats or violence - If title/section number 18 U.S.C. 1981(a) documents conspiracy to obstruct commerce but the nature of offense [s]tate by means of force, violence and threat of injury, which is similar language used in subsection (b) of 1981, can such erroneous description of subsection constitute a clerical error, pursuant to Rule 36?

II Does erroneous description of nature of offense constitute legal error oppose to clerical error
