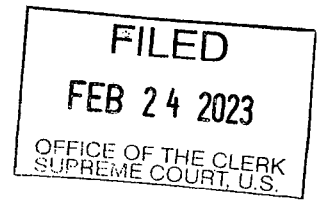

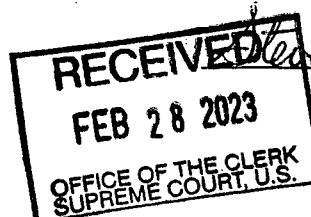

**AFFIDAVIT OR DECLARATION

*12. Continued; On Monday, August 28th, 1993, me, my wife and our three daughters became involved in a 21 year federal case. The Italian mafia, associated with my late grandfather, Ralph Farnasello (d. 1984), put a contract out on my life, because they thought I had stolen money from them - my grandfather did, years before I was even born, but I was blamed for it.

We had FBI protection; FBI agent Alan Norris; FBI agent Gerald Clark (now deceased); FBI agent Steven Clark; FBI agent Matthew Clark (my identical twin brother, separated at birth); FBI agent Michael Ganett; Former FBI agent, now CIA agent Ken White (AKA Kim Wang).

We were not allowed to work (on the run and in hiding), and had to borrow money to survive, but I was also forced to fund our entire 21 year case with over 2 million dollars I borrowed, and gave vast majority to head agent, Ken White.

Case was inadvertently compromised by ATF agents, and FBI simply walked away and left me "holding the bag." They made me the scapegoat to conceal our 21 year case, a "war" against the mafia. I am continuing to fight, to prove the truth, but now have to do so with permanent spinal cord damage, multiple neurological signs and symptoms, and from a wheelchair, with a past surgical operation (fusion of C2-C6) which has greatly, and negatively affected my health, thanks to constitutional violations and torts, I suffered at the hands of FMC-Butner's federal staff, and recognized by Honorable Judge Louise Blanton, in initial filing, case NO: 5:17-CT-03094-FL (see Appendix C)
