The district court found appellant financially eligible for appointed counsel and never revoked that status. Appellant, therefore, may proceed on appeal in forma pauperis without further authorization, and his motion to proceed in forma pauperis (Docket Entry No. 5) is unnecessary. *See* Fed. R. App. P. 24(a)(3).

Appellant's motion for appointment of counsel (Docket Entry No. 4) is granted. Counsel will be appointed by separate order.

The Clerk will electronically serve this order on the appointing authority for the District of Oregon, who will locate appointed counsel. The appointing authority is requested to send notification of the name, address, and telephone number of appointed counsel to the Clerk of this court at counselappointments@ca9.uscourts.gov within 14 days of locating counsel.

Appellant must designate the reporter's transcript by July 12, 2021. The transcript is due August 11, 2021. The opening brief and excerpts of record are due September 20, 2021; the answering brief is due October 20, 2021; and the optional reply brief is due within 21 days after service of the answering brief.
