**Re: *Council for Education and Research on Toxics v. California Chamber of Commerce, No. 22-699***

I am counsel of record for Respondent in the above-captioned case. The petition for a writ of certiorari was filed on January 24, 2023, and was docketed on January 27, 2023. The Court called for a response to the petition on February 6, 2023, and the response is currently due on March 8, 2023.

Due to the press of other business, I respectfully request a seven-day extension of time within which to file a response to the petition with the response due no later than March 15, 2023. The extension is warranted because counsel for Respondent had several pressing deadlines shortly after the Court called for a response, including a hearing on cross-motions for summary judgment on February 15 in California state court, a hearing on demurrer on February 16 in California state court, filing a merits brief in this Court on February 22, 2023, filing a reply brief in the Oregon court of appeals on February 23, filing an amicus brief in this Court and an opening brief in the Delaware Supreme Court on February 24, and a substantive hearing on post-judgment relief in California state court on February 28. Counsel also have several imminent deadlines in the coming weeks, including a reply brief in the Delaware Superior Court due on March 8, a substantive hearing in California state court on March 8, and an opposition brief in the Eighth Circuit due in early April. Counsel also intend to file a motion for summary judgment in the underlying action in late March. Respondent has not previously sought any extensions in this matter.

Petitioner does not oppose the requested extension.
