**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO PROCEED IN
FORMA PAUPERIS**

The Petitioner, DEANDRE MARKEE KING, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 39, hereby moves this Court for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*.

1. A judge of the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia determined Mr. King to be indigent pursuant to 18 U.S.C. § 3006A. Undersigned counsel was appointed to represent Mr. King in the district court and on appeal before the United States Court of Appeals for the Eleventh Circuit.

2. Mr. King was incarcerated in this federal case between his arrest on June 21, 2012, until his release from prison on May 22, 2022, and although he has been on supervised release for more than nine months, he remains indigent. Through counsel, he will file in this Court a *Petition for a Writ of Certiorari* and wishes to do so *in forma pauperis*.

WHEREFORE Mr. King asks this Court to grant this motion to allow him to proceed *in forma pauperis*.
