The petitioner, Raymond Charles Lee, pro se, pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 44, requests rehearing of the Court's denial of his petition for writ of certiorari, dated May 2, 2023, for the reasons set forth below:


REASONS FOR GRANTING REHEARING  
\*\*\*\*\*

1. The Court of Appeals below held that the district court lacked the discretion to consider intervening changes in the law brought by *Apprendi v New Jersey*, 530 U.S. 466 (2000).
2. The petitioner sought certiorari review in light of *Concepcion v. United States*, \_\_\_ U.S. \_\_\_ (2022), which held that district courts may consider intervening changes in the law when deciding motions under Section 404 of the First Step Act. The Court denied review.
3. Rehearing is warranted in this case because the Court has granted every petition seeking certiorari review in light of *Concepcion*, *supra*. See *Johnson v United States*, 143 S.Ct. 482 (2022); *Harper v. United States*, 142 S.Ct. 2998 (2022); *Fields v. United States*, 142 S.Ct. 2899 (2022); *Houston v. United States*, 142 S.Ct. 2893; and *Bryant v United States*, 142 S.Ct. 2900 (2022).


CONCLUSION
