Dear Mr. Harris:

Pursuant to United States Supreme Court Rule 30(4), the State of Arizona respectfully requests a 14-day extension of time to file the Brief in Opposition to Petitioner Manuel Ovante's Petition for Writ of Certiorari. This is the State's third request for an extension of time. The Brief in Opposition is currently due July 21, 2023. The State of Arizona requests an extension of time to and including August 4, 2023. Since the last motion to extend, the State's draft of its brief in opposition has undergone supervisory review. However, 14 additional days are necessary to allow time to complete revisions to the brief and allow for final supervisory review before the brief can be filed.
