STATEMENT OF THE CASE

The Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit
Consolidated 22-56 and 22-289.

The heat was turned OFF at Green Haven
exposing plaintiff to bitter cold temperatures
in violation of the Eighth Amendment
to the United States Constitution.

Plaintiff was sexually assaulted several times
at Elmira by prison guards and then retaliated
by prison guards at both Elmira and Green Haven
During facility lockdown at Green Haven plaintiff
was assaulted and battered by prison guards
which plaintiff sustained several injuries from
the assault and battery, including a concussion,
strained neck, shoulder injury, back injury and
contusion.

REASONS FOR GRANTING THE PETITION
