
Dear Mr. Bickell:

I am counsel for respondent in the above-referenced case. On February 7, 2023, a certiorari petition was docketed in this case. On behalf of respondent, I did not file a waiver. The Court called for a response on March 27, 2023. Unless extended by the Court, the response would be due on April 26, 2023. For the reasons that follow, and pursuant to Rule 30.4, I respectfully request an extension of 30 days, to and including May 26, 2023.

I have several pressing obligations during these upcoming weeks, including recent completion of an internationally televised trial, three responses to Motions for Summary Judgement on other cases, as well as multiple depositions in this and another case.
