Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 32.3, I write to request that respondent the City of Los Angeles be permitted to lodge with the Court:

- The complaint filed by petitioner Frank Revere in the California Superior Court for the County of Los Angeles in *Revere v. Mossanen*, No. 22STCV08231.
- The superior court's judgment in Mr. Revere's favor in the same case.

These documents, referenced on page 29 of the brief in opposition, undermine the petitioners' contention that they were forced to "refrain in perpetuity from terminating a tenancy" (i.e., Mr. Mossanen's).
