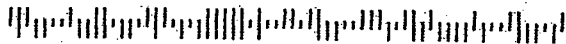

**FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW ON  
APPLICATION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS**

On this day came to be considered the applicant's application for writ of habeas corpus. Having considered this pleading, the State's response, the affidavit of trial counsel, and the official court records, this Court enters the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

**HISTORY OF THE CASE**

A jury convicted Applicant of aggravated sexual assault of a child younger than fourteen years of age. The trial court assessed punishment at seventy-five years' confinement in the Texas Department of Criminal Justice, Institutional Division. The Fifth District Court of Appeals affirmed the conviction.

This is Applicant's first application for a writ of habeas corpus in this case.
