ORDER DENYING PETITION FOR WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS

On January 30, 2023, Petitioner, *pro se*, filed a petition for a writ of habeas corpus. Petitioner contends the trial court erred in denying him extraordinary relief in Cleveland County District Court Case No. WH-2022-7. The trial court denied this petition for a writ of habeas corpus in an order issued January 3, 2023.


For a writ of habeas corpus, Petitioner must establish that his confinement is unlawful or that he is entitled to immediate release. Rule 10.6(C), *Rules of the Oklahoma Court of Criminal Appeals*, Title 22, Ch.18, App. (2023); *Ekstrand v. State*, 1990 OK CR 21, 791 P.2d 92. Petitioner has not met this burden as he has not shown that his confinement is unlawful or that he is entitled to immediate release.

This Court's Rule 10.1(C) directs that it is the responsibility of the Petitioner to ensure the record in this request for extraordinary relief is filed with the Clerk of this Court with the petition and supporting brief. Rule 10.1(C), *Rules of the Oklahoma Court of Criminal Appeals*, Title 22, Ch.18, App. (2023). This includes any supporting evidence presented to the trial court. Petitioner has not provided this Court with any documentation or pleadings establishing that he has been erroneously denied extraordinary relief.


Accordingly, Petitioner's petition to this Court for a writ of habeas corpus is **DENIED**.
