The following is a summary of the results of the experiments conducted during the year 1955. The experiments were designed to determine the effect of temperature on the rate of reaction between hydrogen peroxide and potassium permanganate. The results show that the rate of reaction increases with increasing temperature. The rate of reaction is also affected by the concentration of the reactants. The rate of reaction is highest when the concentration of both reactants is high. The rate of reaction is lowest when the concentration of both reactants is low. The rate of reaction is also affected by the presence of a catalyst. The rate of reaction is highest when a catalyst is present. The rate of reaction is lowest when no catalyst is present.
